About Youth Ambassadors

What is a Youth Ambassador?

Youth Ambassadors is a volunteer program for high school students with the Mission Inn Foundation, a nonprofit that preserves and interprets the cultural heritage of the Mission Inn and Riverside. Students who complete Youth Ambassador training in good standing earn community service hours leading tours of the Mission Inn Hotel & Spa for children and families, assisting with family programs, and attending regular monthly meetings to assist in the development of museum activities and special projects.

Who can apply?

Students in Riverside County with:

- Access to reliable transportation to and from the Mission Inn Foundation
- A 2.0 GPA or higher
- Entering 10th, 11th, or 12th grade fall 2017

Applicants must be dependable, creative and positive, have good communication skills, and interested in working with the public.

How do I become a Youth Ambassador?

Submit your completed application form to the Mission Inn Foundation by **Friday, June 2, 2017**.

Successful applicants will be contacted for an interview by June 9. Interviews will be held **Friday, June 16 and Saturday, June 17** at the Mission Inn Foundation.

Applicants selected for the program attend summer training **July 25-August 4, 2017** covering local history and how to lead exterior tours of the Mission Inn. Training will be held Tuesday-Friday mornings, 9am-noon.

All training classes take place at the Mission Inn. Makeup classes are **not** offered.



What is the time commitment?

Regular monthly meetings are scheduled the second Monday of each month from 4-5:30pm. Regular volunteer opportunities are available on Sundays and weekday evenings, including:

- First Sundays of each month
- Mission Inn Run: November 11 & 12
- Festival of Lights: November- December
- Other city events, including: Long Night of Arts & Innovation, Lunar Festival, etc.

What do I get?

We are grateful for Youth Ambassadors who volunteer their time and talent. In return, we provide participants the following benefits:

- Leadership and public speaking skills development
- Training and classes on Riverside history
- Social occasions with fellow Youth Ambassadors
