About Youth Ambassadors

What is a Youth Ambassador?

Youth Ambassadors is a volunteer program for high school students with the **Mission Inn Foundation**, a nonprofit that preserves and interprets the cultural heritage of the Mission Inn and Riverside. Students attend training in the summer. During the school year (Sept. 2018—May 2019) Youth Ambassadors experience and share our great city and the Mission Inn by leading exterior tours, assisting family programs, participating on the Museum's Community Outreach Team, and creating a team history project.

Who can apply?

Students in Riverside County with:

- A 2.0 GPA or higher
- Entering 10th, 11th, or 12th grade fall 2018
- Access to reliable transportation to and from the Mission Inn Foundation

Applicants must be dependable, positive, have good communication skills, and interested in working with the public.

How do I become a Youth Ambassador?

Submit your completed application and responses by **Friday, May 25, 2018**.

Select applicants will be contacted for an interview by June 1. Interviews will be held **Friday, June 8 and Saturday, June 9** at the Mission Inn Museum. Applicants will be contacted with final selections by June 16.

Applicants selected for the program attend summer training **July 24-August 3**. Training is Tuesday-Friday mornings, 9:00am-12:00 pm.

All training classes take place at the Mission Inn. Candidates are expected to attend the full training — makeup classes are **not** offered.



What is the time commitment?

Required meetings are held the second Monday of each month Sept.—May from 4:30-6:00pm. A minimum of 2-4 volunteer hours per month is required. Volunteer opportunities are scheduled on weekends and may include:

- 9/11 Day of Service (Sept.)
- First Sundays of each month Oct.—May
- Mission Inn Run: November 10 & 11
- Community Outreach Team booths: Hometown Heroes (Sept.), Turkey Trot (Nov.), Lunar Festival, (Jan.), Black History Month Expo (Feb.), Tamale Festival (Apr.), and others
