

# The Mission Inn Poem

### HISTORY

Did you know the Mission Inn, Frank Miller, and Riverside were featured in a poem? In 1907, famed architect Arthur Benton published a "book-length poem about the Inn, the missions, and Riverside"<sup>1</sup>. Illustrations of the hotel were drawn throughout the pages of the poem by artist, William Sharp.<sup>2</sup>

Arthur Benton wrote several lines of poetry about Frank Miller and the Inn. A portion of Arthur Benton's poetry is provided below, along with the historical context of each line.

### Haiku:

"A haiku is an unrhymed Japanese poetic form that consists of 17 syllables arranged in three lines containing five, seven, and five syllables, respectively. A haiku expresses much and suggests more in the fewest possible words."<sup>4</sup>

### Example Haiku:

Line 1 (5 syllables): The Mission Inn Rocks Line 2 (7 syllables): Captivating History Line 3 (5 syllables): Let Us Take A Tour
